<b>Subject: A Level GEOGRAPHY - Human Element</b>

<b>Year 12</b>	<p><b>Population</b> This builds on the IGCSE knowledge. Students will investigate the distribution of global population and the factors which influence this. Students investigate how historical, physical and political factors affect population as well as how global population and food production are interlinked.</p>	<p><b>Migration</b> Students build on their IGCSE knowledge. Students will investigate the patterns of migration and the reasons for migration. Students will learn about the impacts of migration on the social, political, economic and physical aspects of geography.</p>	<p><b>Settlement dynamics</b> Students build on their IGCSE knowledge. Students will delve deeper into the different types of settlement and the changes which have taken place over time and how they will evolve in the future.</p>	<b>AS Examinations</b>
<b>Year 13</b>	<p><b>Global interdependence</b> This topic considers global trade patterns. Students will develop an understanding of international debt and aid. Tourism is the second area of study within the topic and learners will be able to recognise why management of tourism is necessary.</p>	<p><b>Environmental management</b> This topic allows learners to consider the role of renewable energy and how energy supplies are managed.
