6. I can identify where a writer has used precise word choices for effect to impact on the reader.		
7. I can make inferences and begin to justify them with evidence from the text (e.g. infer characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions).		
8. I can take an active part in discussions about books that I have read independently or shared with the class/group.		
9. I can talk about several books that I have finished.		
10. I can retell stories such as fairy tales, folktales or myths and legends.		
11. I can prepare poems or plays to be read aloud and to perform, showing understanding through intonation, tone, volume and action.		
12. I can use a range of strategies to help me select a book (e.g. blurb, read first page, favourite genre/author).		
13. I can use a dictionary to check the meaning of words I have read.
