



Network International School Early Years Foundation Stage Home Learning Guide

Introduction

The Early Years Foundation Stage Home Learning aims to provide children with a high quality Home Learning programme that will support children's development in the 7 areas of the curriculum. The home learning will reflect our play based philosophy as much as possible. Teachers and parents will need to work together to provide the best opportunities for the children whilst they are away from school.

Network International School, sets high expectations for all our students and expect that they will fully engage with the activities and learning materials to the best of their abilities.

This guide will explain the format and expectations of Home Learning in the Early Years Foundation Stage. Should you need further clarification please do not hesitate to email your child's class teacher and these can be found later on in this document.

Home Learning Expectations

The expectations of our Home Learning are that all children partake in the programme. The teachers will work to provide learning opportunities for whole classes and cannot provide individual learning plans for each child. Whilst we will provide individual feedback and next steps, the lessons we provide will be the same for all children in each year.

Role of the students

- Have fun and engage with the home learning programme.

Role of Parents

Due to the age of the children the parents or other adult in the home will play a key part in ensuring that the Home Learning programme is successful.

- Parents must provide an updated email, through the parent portal, and check in regularly.
- Parents must help their child feedback their learning to teachers via Seesaw. This could come in many formats photos, videos, written emails, voice recordings.
- Parents need to adhere to the timetable provided (as much as possible) to ensure routine and an age appropriate amount of work is happening.

Role of the Teachers

- To plan age appropriate learning experiences and activities to support children's learning in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum.
- To support parents with the Home Learning programme.
- To provide resources to support the online lessons and activities.
- To provide daily contact with parents and children via zoom and seesaw.



Learning Experience

In keeping with our school Early Years ethos, we want the learning experience at home to remain active, child centered and holistic.

Foundation 2 and 3

Students will undertake a revised timetable that carefully balances learning and screen-time requirements

Key information:

- There will be daily live video sessions with the Teacher.
- There will be a variety of online and offline learning activities.
- Teachers will provide ongoing feedback via SeeSaw and email.
- Teachers will upload lesson activities onto SeeSaw the evening before.
- Children should not attempt the activities before the live video sessions as the activities may be a follow on from the live sessions.
- Students should complete the tasks and activities by the end of each day.
- Instructions and links for live sessions will be sent out each day.
- If a task or activity is taking significantly longer than the intended timeframe please let the class teacher know.

Further information for Foundation 3

Foundation 3 will have 1 live lesson a day, this will alternate between Phonics and Maths. This lesson will be in addition to the 2 daily circle time zooms.

One of the daily activities on Seesaw will support the live lesson and should not be attempted by the children until after the live lesson with the teacher.

The other subjects such as music, creative, Knowledge and Understanding of the World (KUW) etc. will be prepared and published via Seesaw, they will be expected to be completed each day. These are in bold on the timetable
